

RainbowRoom is an affirming and safe place for lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans and questioning (LGBTQ) teens and young adults (13 to 21).

- RainbowRoom is a drop-in center located in an intimate, informal space with room for a variety of activities.
- RainbowRoom is open every Sunday from 3 pm-6 pm for discussion, social and activity time.
- RainbowRoom is located in the “Green Room” of the Hartford Gay and Lesbian Health Collective at 1841 Broad Street, Hartford. Parking is available in the lot next to the building or anywhere on the street.
- During the social/activity time, LGBTQ teens and young adults can network with others, participate in activities, use arts and crafts, play board games, read a book or magazine, listen to music, dance, watch a movie or just hang out with friends.
- Impromptu discussions give participants a chance to share personal experiences in an affirming and supportive environment. In addition, bi-monthly educational programming provides for lively, informative, and honest discussions about coming out, relationships, school, health and other issues which relate to being an LGBTQ teen or young adult.
